The hurt that is caused by nasty messages/comments can have long-lasting effects on our children and it is worrying that when we try to address these issues many parents have no idea what their children are doing on-line. This includes being on inappropriate websites, viewing inappropriate materials, playing games that are not for their age group and talking to strangers online.

All children will have access to the internet at some stage and it is our responsibility as parents to supervise their access, to know how they are behaving on-line and what they have access to. It is also our responsibility to educate ourselves so that we can keep our children safe and in turn educate them about their on-line activities and their responsibilities.

To show the children how important these issues are to us as a school we will be giving out homework passes on the night. If a parent/guardian attends the talk we will give you a homework pass for your child.
