Couch to 5k: The programme is starting on Monday the 16th of January and will run for 12 weeks. All children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult willing to run with them as we are not

responsible for their safety. It is on every Monday from 2:50p.m.-3.20p.m. This programme will start on Monday the 16th of January and finish on Monday the 3rd of April. It is €1 per person per week. Forms are available in the office or from myself and all adults must sign up if they are interested in joining.
